Cash Assistance

1. Find the **Government** section of your local phone book (may be blue pages, probably in front of the phone book).
2. Look for the heading **State**.
3. In the **State** section look for the topics **Social and Health Services, Welfare, Cash Assistance, Family Assistance or Temporary Aid**

Provides financial assistance to needy families—some states will also assist single, needy adults.

Employment Assistance

1. Find the **Government** section of your local phone book (may be blue pages, probably in front of the phone book).
2. Look for the heading **State**.
3. Then look for **Employment Security** or **Unemployment**

Help finding work, filing for unemployment and sometimes assistance with creating a resume.
